These activities are sometimes called ear exercises because they focus on hearing the parts or sounds in a word. Here are a couple activities you can do with your child this summer to continue this phonological awareness.

1. Reciting nursery rhymes. Make it interactive by leaving out some of the rhyming words to see if your child can produce the rhyme. For example, Hickory dickory dock, the mouse ran up the _____. (clock)
2. Name game: choose a sound and ask your child to name other things that begin with that sound.
